INSTRUCTIONS:

1 – PRINT A COPY OF THE DOODLE DOG PAGE

2 – IT IS PREFERRED THAT YOU TRACE THE DOODLE DOG INTO YOUR SKETCHBOOK BUT IF NOT, YOU CAN USE THE FOLLOWING PAGE. YOU MUST HAVE TWO DOODLE DOGS ON ONE PAGE.

3 – YOUR DOODLE DOG MUST HAVE AN EYE.

4 – THE DOODLE DOGS MUST BE "OPPOSITES". THINK OF A THEME THAT IS BASED ON OPPOSITES: GOOD VS. EVIL, LIGHT VS. DARK... THEY MUST SHOW A COMPLETE OPPOSITE IDEA SO THINK BEFORE YOU START.

5 – OUTLINE YOUR DRAWINGS IN BLACK SHARPIE AND COLOR THEM IN – COLORED PENCIL, CRAYONS, PAINT, WHATEVER.

6 – COMPLETE 2 OF THEM FOR FULL CREDIT – THEY MUST BE COMPLETELY DIFFERENT IN ORDER TO QUALIFY AND THE THEME MUST BE WRITTEN SOMEWHERE ON THE DOODLE DOG PAGE.

YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DO ANYTHING THAT IS DEEMED "EASY" LIKE BLACK VS. WHITE... THERE MUST BE A THOUGHT PROCESS BEHIND YOUR DESIGN. IF IT'S TOO EASY THEN IT WILL NOT BE GRADED.
