

# Sketchbook Assignment #5

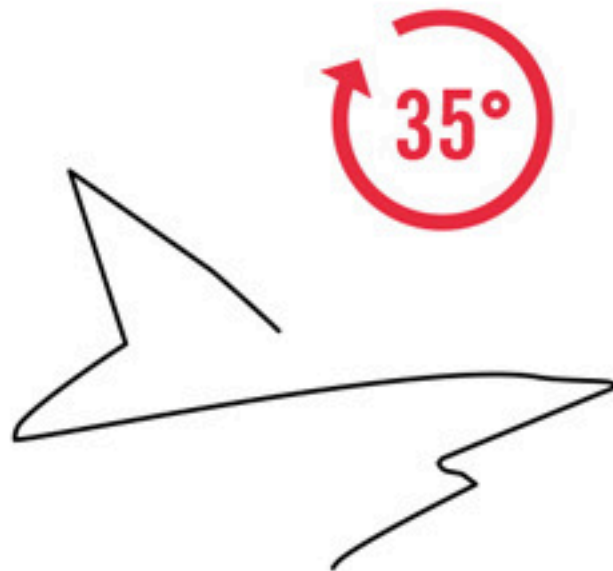
Your assignment is to draw a doodle that uses the pre-existing line into your doodle. You must use all 8 lines to come up with your individual doodles. There is no right or wrong, good or bad - allow yourself to be creative. Don't look for the easy way out, force your mind to explore other possibilities. Any orientation whether vertical, horizontal, upside down or side ways is acceptable.

## Rules

- Print the doodle page.
- Trace the doodle you are going to use in your sketchbook (sketch paper). Remember, the direction of the doodle plays into what you are drawing so trace it the way you are going to use it.
- The original doodle line must be traced in **BLACK** (see examples) while the rest of the drawing can be in **RED** or **BLUE**.
- Whatever you draw must be based on something REAL... It can't be a doodle with a doodle line in it. If you have too many weird things, you will not get points.
- Color your drawing... All 8 of your doodles should fit onto 1 page. If you need more paper, please do not use the back side of the paper.

Please see the example page to understand completely what you are supposed to do. Remember you are tracing all 8.
